Cover	Current appropriate (Detachment, Department, National) Cover. (Past Department Commandants and Past Pack Leaders can retain the Department Cover). A Solid Gold MC Emblem is worn on left side of cover. The right side of the cover may have the Devil Dog patch and identification of the Division, Department or Detachment and current Office held. Life member may also be indicated. It is recommended that the cover NOT be worn at indoor formal occasions or ceremonies. (F) No cover worn with Formal Dress.
